Community Relations

Award of Diplomas to World War II and Korean Hostilities Veterans

The Regional School District #10 Board of Education may award a high school diploma to a veteran of World War II or the Korean hostilities who left high school prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed forces of the United States and did not receive a diploma as a consequence of such service.

A "veteran of World War II" is defined as any person honorably discharged from or released under honorable conditions from active service in the armed forces whose services lasted at least ninety (90) days and occurred between December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946. The "armed forces" are defined as the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, and Air Force.

A "veteran of the Korean hostilities" is defined as any person honorably discharged from or released under honorable conditions from active service in the armed forces whose services lasted at least ninety (90) days and occurred between June 27, 1950 to October 27, 1953.
