E-reader Policy Agreement Form

Regional School District #10 Interim Policy for E-readers

(This policy will go into effect on March 14, 2011 and will be reviewed on June 6, 2011.)

This policy applies to e-readers (e.g., Kindle, Nook) and to other electronic devices that include an e-reader application (e.g., iPad, tablet computer). The policy excludes electronic devices that incorporate any cell phone or texting capability (e.g., iPhone, Android, Blackberry, "smart phone," etc.), which are covered by the existing cell phone policy.

Guidelines:

During the instructional school day (LSM, 7:25 a.m.-2:00 p.m.; Har-Bur, 8:13 a.m.-2:48 p.m.):

- E-readers may be used in classrooms with permission of the classroom teacher and for valid instructional purposes (including independent reading or sustained silent reading).
- E-readers may be used in the Learning Center and in classroom study halls for valid instructional purposes (including independent reading).
- E-readers may be used by seniors in the LSM senior courtyard.
- Students may not use e-readers in cafeteria study halls or during lunch.
- E-readers may not be used for game playing or other uses other than reading.
- Students may not use e-readers or other electronic devices covered by this policy to connect to the Internet either through the Region 10 network or an external network (e.g., wifi, 3G or 4G network).
