**ADULT EDUCATION**

The Regional School District #10 recognizes that education is a lifelong process. Therefore, the Board shall establish and maintain a program of adult education classes for residents of the school district aged seventeen (17) or older. The Board may elect to provide its adult education program through cooperative arrangements with one or more other Boards of Education, eligible entities, or regional educational service centers.

The adult education program, whether provided directly by Region #10 or through a cooperative arrangement must provide tuition-free classes in Americanization and U.S. citizenship, English for adults with limited English proficiency, and elementary and secondary school completion. Any other subject or activity offered by the adult education program may be made available at fees to be established by the program or cooperative arrangement and consistent with local, state and federal laws.
