**School District Lines**

The Board of Education accepts its responsibility for establishing attendance zones in such a way as to facilitate the educational program. Advance planning for new sites and buildings will be guided by the following criteria in determining school district lines:

1. Educational needs of the students
2. Proximity of students to school plants
3. Safety of students
4. Ages of students serve
5. Nature of the educational program housed
6. Racial/ethnic balance

Elementary School Assignment: The determination of the elementary school (Lake Garda or Harwinton Consolidated) which a child is to attend will be made by the Superintendent of Schools.

Consideration will be given to such factors as location of residence, available transportation and class size.
