Death – Yearbook

The following policy relating to Yearbook recognition of students who pass away while members of a class at Lewis Mills is established:

“A student who passes away while a member of any class, Grades 9 through 12, at Lewis S. Mills High School, may be remembered in an appropriate and respectful way in the Yearbook published in the student’s graduation year. At the family’s request, and if the publication timeline allows, recognition may alternatively be included in the yearbook published in the year of the student’s passing in lieu of the student’s graduation year.

The form of recognition to be given will be determined by the Yearbook advisor in consultation with the school administration. Communication with the family of the deceased student will be through the Yearbook advisor.”
