that she appreciated working together during such a difficult time. She	
commented that she is proud of the bond they have developed.	
Art Johanson, Chairman, Burlington Board of Finance:	
Mr. Johanson encouraged the Board of Education to come in with a 0%	
increase for the 2010-2011 Estimate of Expense.	
Peter Thierry, Chairman, Harwinton Board of Finance:	
Mr. Thierry commended the Board for doing a good job with the current	
year's Estimate of Expenses. He asked the Board to consider a 0%	
salary increase for all employees in the coming year. He encouraged	
the Board to do what they need to do to keep the numbers down. He	
commented that the Town of Harwinton will be working to achieve	
another 0% increase as they did for the current year's town budget.

decision to close for three (3) days. He reported that due to the	
growing trend in absenteeism and the disruption to the educational	
process, everyone felt the closing was necessary. He commented that	
as a result absenteeism went from a high of 28% to 9.3% as of today.
