Graduation Requirement – Administrative Regulation

In order to graduate, a student must accumulate at least 25 credits according to the following subject requirements. Students must also satisfactorily meet the district's performance standard in Language Arts and Mathematics.

1. Four units of English including English 9, English 10, English 11, (American Studies or Advanced Placement English Language Composition), and two half credit English senior electives or AP English Literature and Composition.
2. Three units of history and social sciences including one unit in United States History.
3. Two and ½ units of Wellness/Physical Education/Health.
4. Three units of mathematics.
5. Three units of science (including biology).
6. One unit of art or vocational education. A student may take ½ unit in the arts for one semester and ½ unit in the vocational area to qualify for one unit or may take a unit in either area.
7. One-half unit of Civics and American Government (PA 00-156).
