

Personalized Learning Device (PLD) Insurance

Each student at Lewis Mills High School will have a district issued PLD. The students will be able to bring the device home and are responsible to bring it to school fully charged on a daily basis. As these devices will be traveling with students and used regularly off school property there is an increased chance of accidental damage to the PLD. As with any school owned property (textbooks, instruments, etc.), families are responsible for any damage that requires repairs or replacement of the device.

To help RSD10 and LSM families ensure the devices are able to remain in optimal conditions for learning we are insuring each device at a nominal cost to families. This insurance is required, however; if the cost presents a hardship for your family please speak directly with Mr. Rau. The free/reduced school lunch form will be used to determine eligibility for a reduced fee.

Insurance cost:

- \$30.00 per school year
- \$0 deductible per incident and up to two claims per year

What's Covered:

- Accidental damage
- Unavoidable theft (police report must be submitted and school must be notified within 2 school days of the theft)
- Fire/Flood/Water/Natural Disasters
- Manufacturer Defects
- Power Surge

What's Not covered:

- Lost PLD cost to replace \$390, pen stylus cost to replace \$25, charger cost to replace \$30
- Intentional marking, defacing and/or abuse
- Damage caused by tampering with hardware components or operating system to alter district configurations

The policy will become void for the remainder of the term if:

- More than two (2) claims are made during the policy term (one academic year)
- The technology department determines that damage to the PLD was intentional abuse.

To make a claim bring your PLD to the help desk in the LSM Learning Center.

PLD Insurance will be purchased annually for each academic year.

Payment for insurance is required before the device can be provided to your child. Payment is due no later than Tuesday, September 4, 2018.

Payment in the form of check payable to Regional School District #10 or cash for the exact amount can be turned in to the LSM main office.
