Mills High School; the parents and the student into the hearing was made by John Vecchitto and seconded by Eleanor Parente at 7:30 pm; all in favor; none opposed; motion carried unanimously.

John Vecchitto made a motion that the Board of Education adopt the stipulation agreement submitted by the parties regarding all issues of fact with the amendments set forth by the stipulations and to expel the student, who was subject of the expulsion hearing in accordance with the terms and conditions recommended by the parties, seconded by Eleanor Parente.

Amendment:

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Being as this was the third expulsion hearing for the student, there would be no participation in any school functions or activities, including graduation for the remainder of the school year.

All in favor; none opposed; motion carried unanimously.
