**Food Service Operations**

It is the intent of the Regional School District #10 Board of Education that its Food Service Operations be entirely self-sufficient. The Food Service Operation is a non-profit school food service that participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and complies with all laws and regulations applicable to the NSLP.

Revenues will only be used for the operation or improvement of the district's Food Service Operations and all expenditures shall be made in accordance with the financial management system established by the Connecticut State Department of Education. .

To accomplish the goal of self-sufficiency, the Food Service Operations will be responsible for paying all allowable costs to support the operation and improvement of the food service. These include, reimbursing the Board of Education for any allowed costs incurred on behalf of the Food Service Operations. Such costs include, but are not limited to wages, benefits, food, supplies, repairs, maintenance, custodial support, equipment and related debt (principal only) incurred to purchase equipment for the operation and improvement of food service for Regional School District #10.

It is the explicit intent of the Board of Education that the Food Service Operations will repay any expenditures made by the Board of Education on behalf of the Food Service Operations to the Board of Education.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee may establish procedures to ensure the implementation of this policy.
